

PRE-CANA A SPANISH MARRIAGE PREPARATION RETREAT DIOCESE OF RENO

For many couples, marriage preparation is the first time that they have any personal contact with a priest or deacon. Many engaged couples arrive un-evangelized and lack understanding of the significant importance of marriage in the Church and society. Couples are often unaware not only of Church teachings about marriage, but even the core notions of the Catholic faith and the basic expectations of Catholics. The participation of the priest or deacon in marriage preparation is a key chance to evaluate and set in place remedial actions to get the faithful on track and begin to focus them on married life.

Process to attend a Marriage Preparation Retreat - Pre-Cana

The initial process begins at the parish and involves paperwork, such as producing affidavits of freedom to marry from parents or others close to the couple as well as baptismal certificates issued within the last six months. An engaged couple must also complete a questionnaire, often called a premarital inventory, which helps a priest or pastoral minister to identify areas of disagreement that require further discussion.

All engaged couples are expected to attend a day and a half day long Retreat for Engaged Couples, and convalidation couples with a priest approval.

The retreat is directed to:

Engaged couples, and couples in existing civil marriage or living together and are considering receiving the Sacrament of Matrimony.

Diocesan marriage preparation retreat for Engaged Couples

The pre-cana retreat for engaged couples are half day Saturday and daylong Sunday that feature dynamic presentations designed to provide a firm foundation for your future life together. The topics covered include the essential characteristics of married; a review of the family of origin and how this can affect their relationship, communication, and intimacy in marriage; finances and partnership in marriage; responsible parenthood and a brief introduction on natural family planning; the spirituality of Christian marriage; and the Christian family as the "domestic church." Folders with resource materials are also provided to facilitate ongoing reflection and discussion by the couple. While the retreat is particularly geared to Catholic engaged couples, all engaged couples are welcome.

2024-2025 Dates

The Pre-Cana Marriage Preparation Retreats are scheduled three times a year and run on Saturday from 5 pm – 9 pm and Sunday from 8:30 am – 5 pm. Check-in starts at 4:45 pm on Saturday and 8:00 am on Sunday. The fee for the day, including continental breakfast and materials, is \$90.00 per couple.
