TRAVEL:

- Transportation To & From Reno-Tahoe to Long Beach Airports.
- Airport Transfer Fee's To & From Hotel in Long Beach.
- Transportation Fee's To & From Convention Center & Hotel Daily.

Food/Meals: All participants should bring spending money for daily meals. Very few meals will be covered by the OYYAM. Bring at least \$25 per day spending/meal money.

WHO:

- Youth participants must be in grades 9-12 at the time of the trip.
- Parishes will be responsible register their parish group and assessing the maturity and responsibility of the youth they bring.
- You should have two adults for the first one to ten youth, and one adult for every eight additional youth. We recommend the overall ratio of one adult per six youth. To the best of their ability, groups should have male and female chaperones in proportion to the makeup of the group. additional youth. We recommend the overall ratio of one adult per six youth.
- All participants (adults and youth) are required to have personal medical insurance.

REGISTRATION & TIMELINE:

May 17th 2024 Registration for Youth and Adult participants DUE BY May 17th, 2024. Registration is though the Office of Youth and Young Adult Ministry with the Diocese of Reno. Do not register until you have looked at your calendar and are certain that you can participate. A \$302.00 Non-Refundable Deposit/1st Payment is required at time of registration.



August 1 2024 2nd Payment of \$302.00 Non-Refundable is due. Registration for Youth and Adult participants CLOSES on August 15, 2024. Limited registration may be available after this date with a substantial price increase. Registration after this date requires a \$602.00 deposit/1st payment.



3rd/Final Payment of \$302.00 Non-Refundable Due. No Changes to participants can occur after October 15th. Required Paperwork will be due by October 15th as well.
